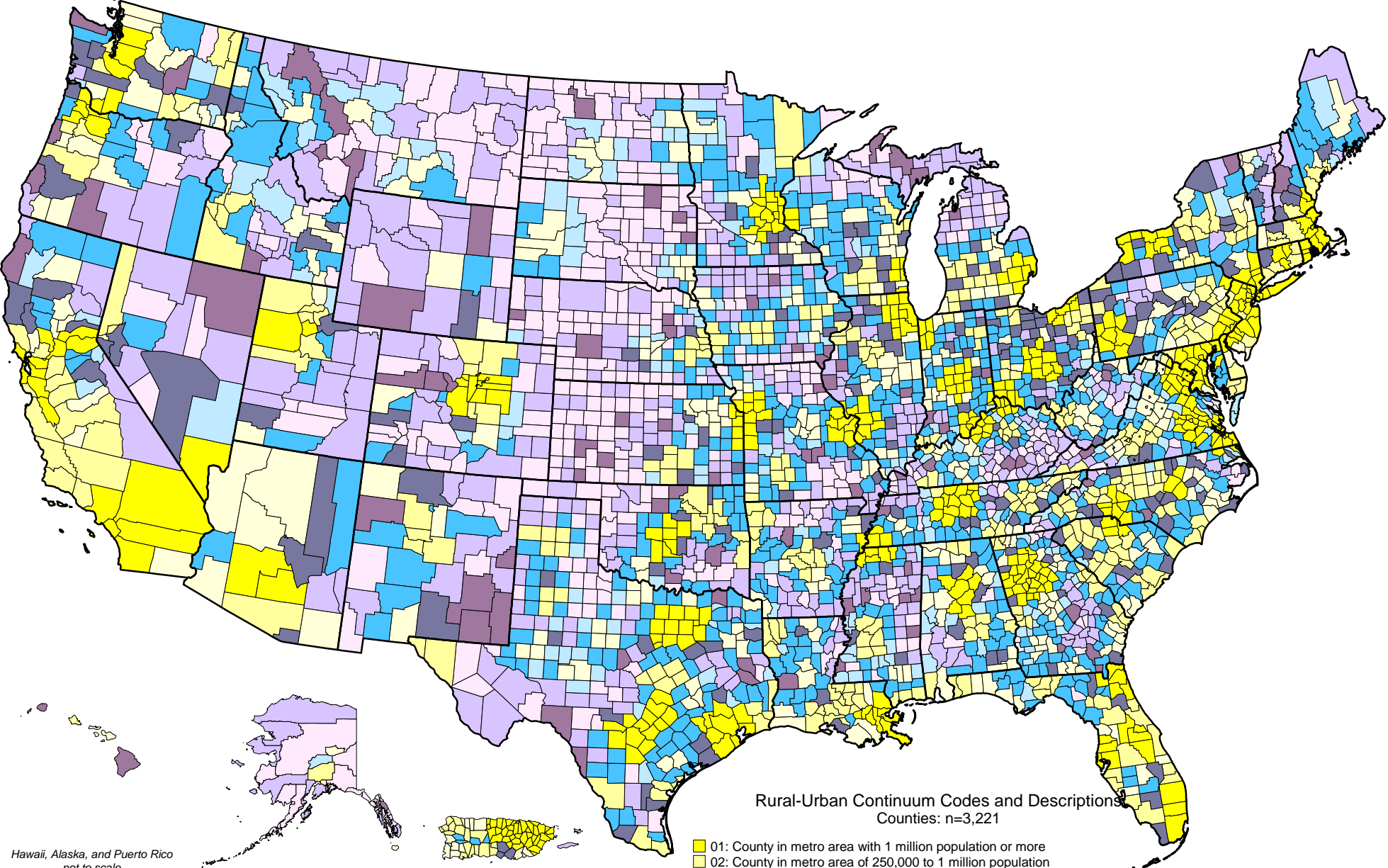


Rural-Urban Continuum Codes by County, 2013

Rural-Urban Continuum Codes and Descriptions
Counties: n=3,221

- 01: County in metro area with 1 million population or more
- 02: County in metro area of 250,000 to 1 million population
- 03: County in metro area of fewer than 250,000 population
- 04: Nonmetro county with urban pop. of 20,000 or more, adjacent to metro area
- 05: Nonmetro county with urban pop. of 20,000 or more, not adjacent to metro area
- 06: Nonmetro county with urban pop. of 2,500-19,999, adjacent to metro area
- 07: Nonmetro county with urban pop. of 2,500-19,999, not adjacent to metro area
- 08: Nonmetro county less than 2,500 urban population, adj. to metro area
- 09: Nonmetro county less than 2,500 urban population, not adj. to metro area
