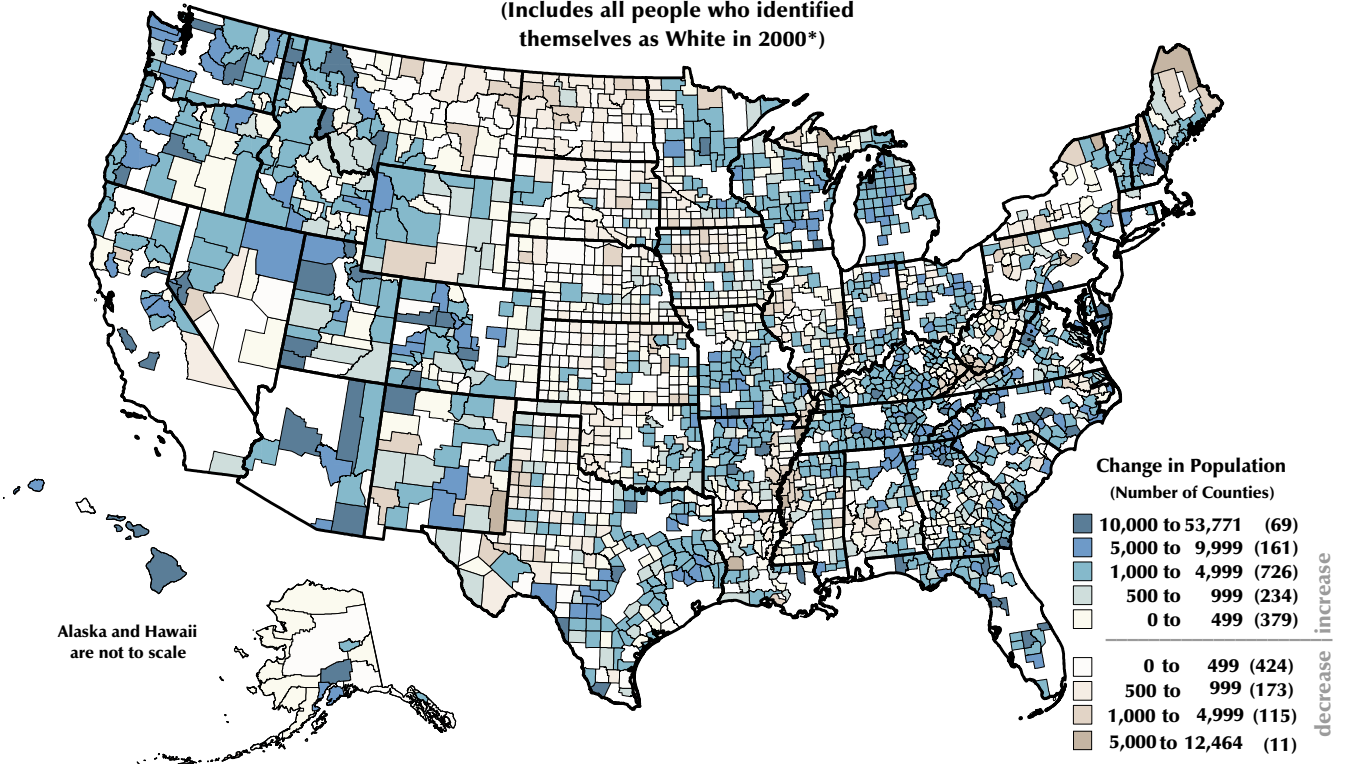


## Change in White Population 1990-2000

### Nonmetropolitan Counties

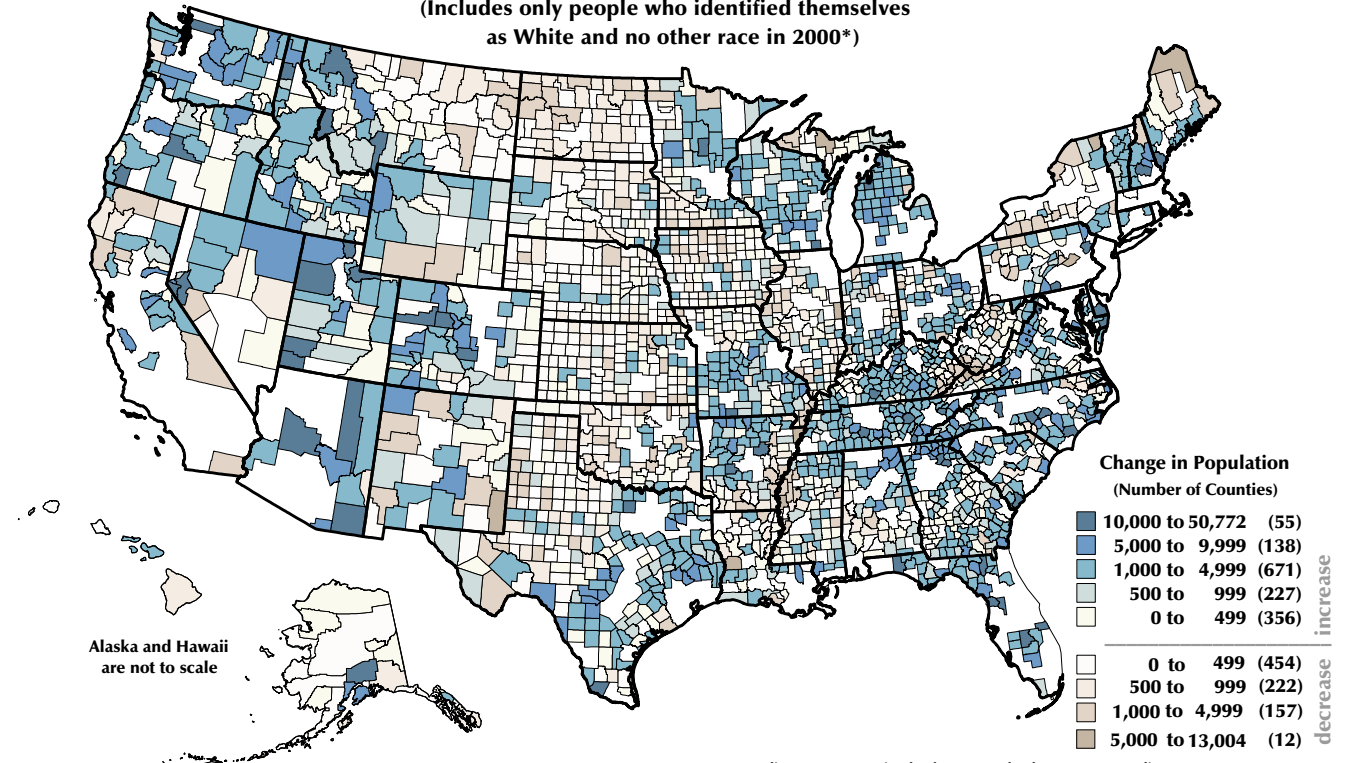
(Includes all people who identified themselves as White in 2000\*)

Metropolitan areas are omitted. The New England County Metropolitan Area (NECMA) definition is used to classify nonmetropolitan areas in New England.

\*In the 1990 Census, respondents were allowed to choose only one race; they could choose more than one race in the 2000 Census.

All people choosing White includes those who chose only White and those who chose White and at least one other race. Only people choosing White includes those who only chose White and no other race.
