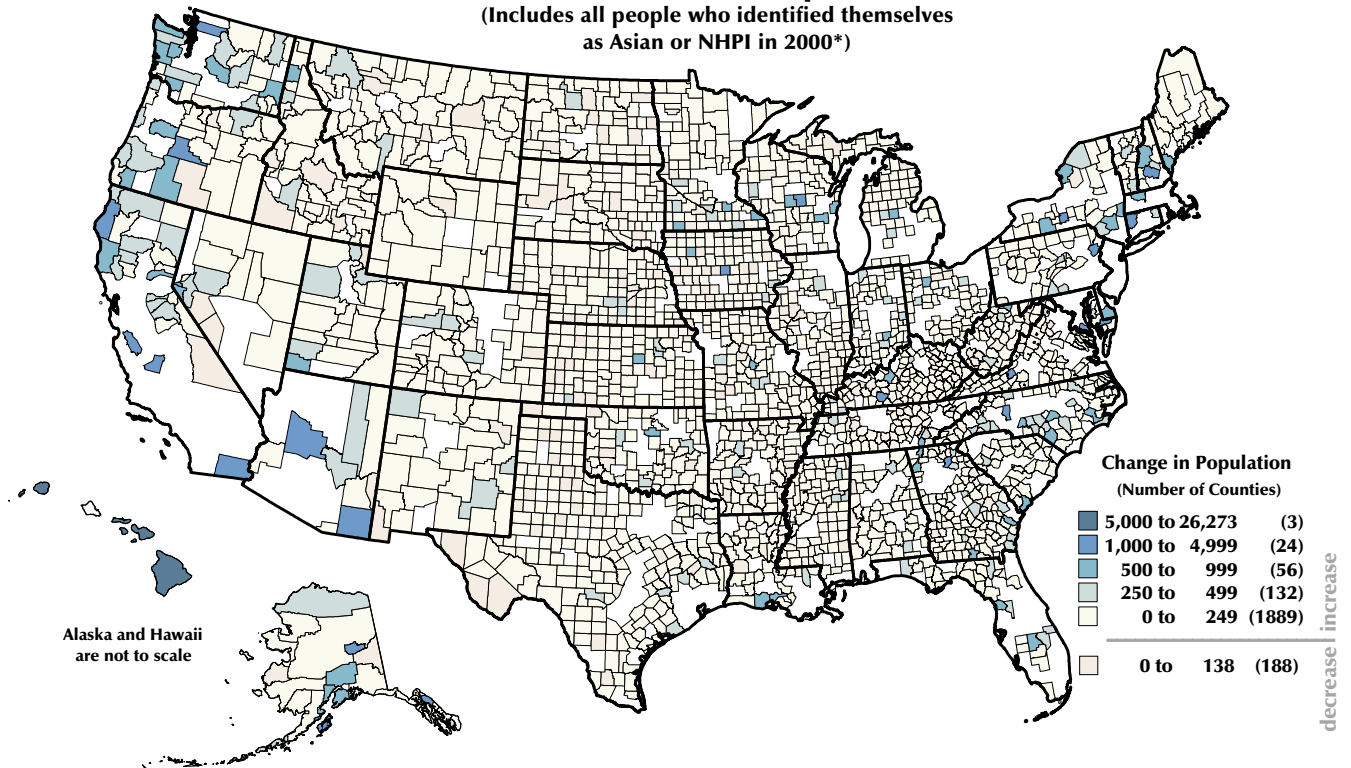


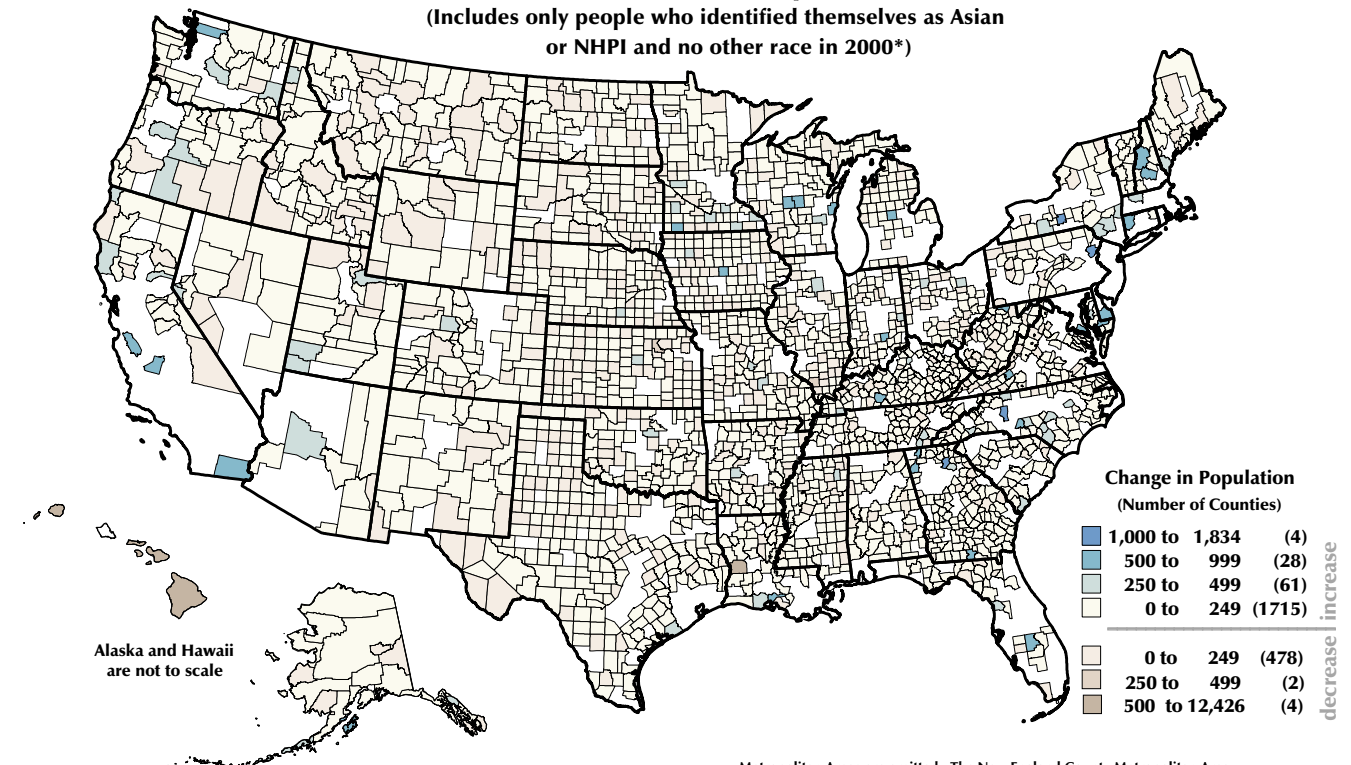
## Change in Asian, Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander (NHPI) 1990-2000, Nonmetropolitan Counties

\*In the 1990 Census, respondents were allowed to choose only one race; they could choose more than one race in the 2000 Census.
