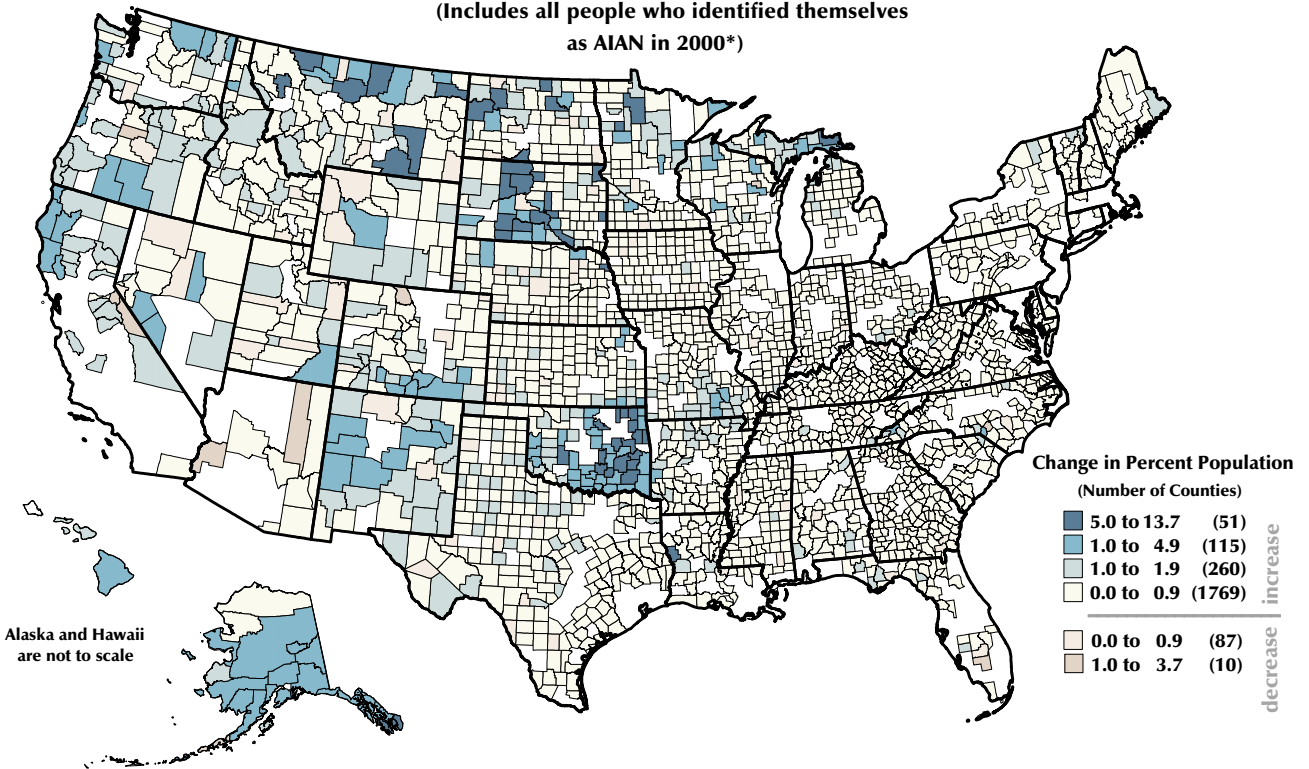


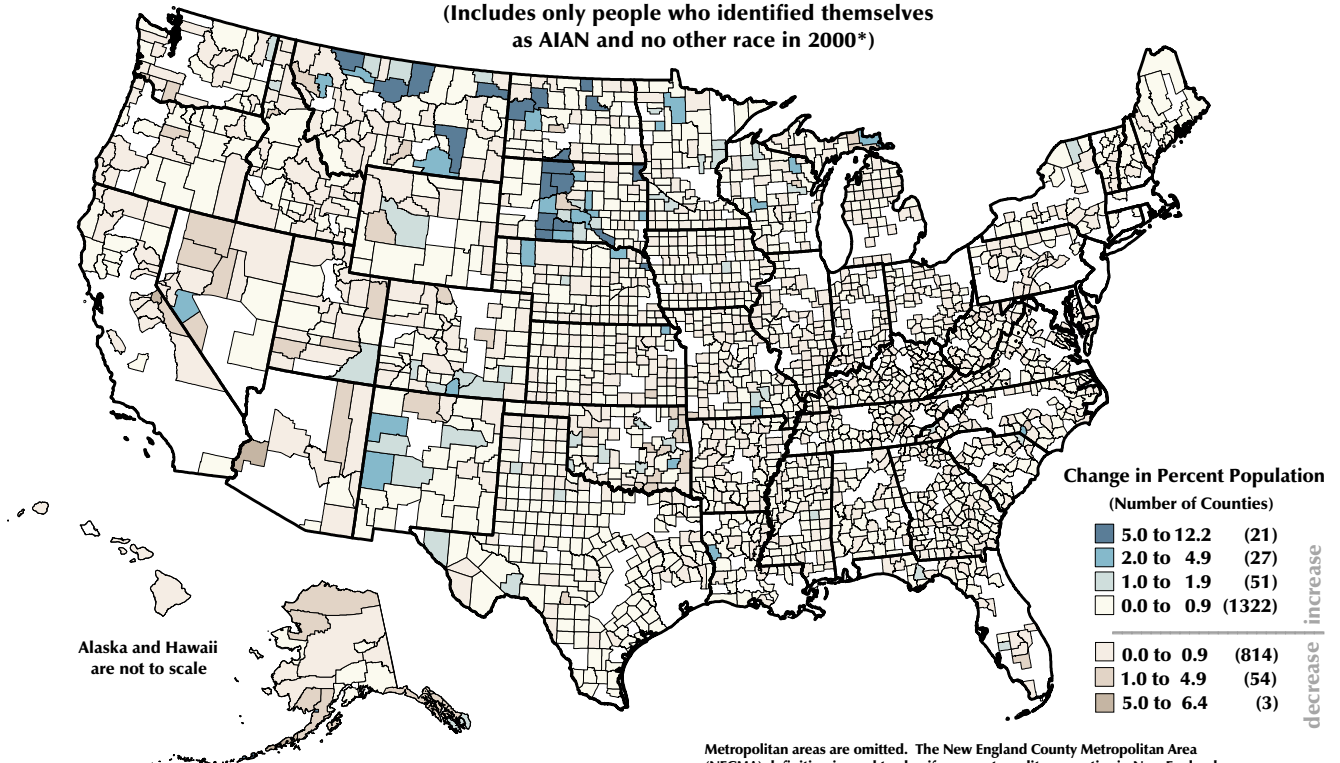
## Change in Percent American Indian or Alaska Native (AIAN) 1990-2000, Nonmetropolitan Counties

Metropolitan areas are omitted. The New England County Metropolitan Area (NECMA) definition is used to classify nonmetropolitan counties in New England.

\*In 1990 Census, respondents were allowed to choose only one race; they could choose more than one race in the 2000 Census.

All people choosing American Indian or Alaska Native (AIAN) include those who chose only AIAN, and those who chose AIAN and at least one other race.

Only people choosing AIAN includes those who chose only AIAN and no other race.
