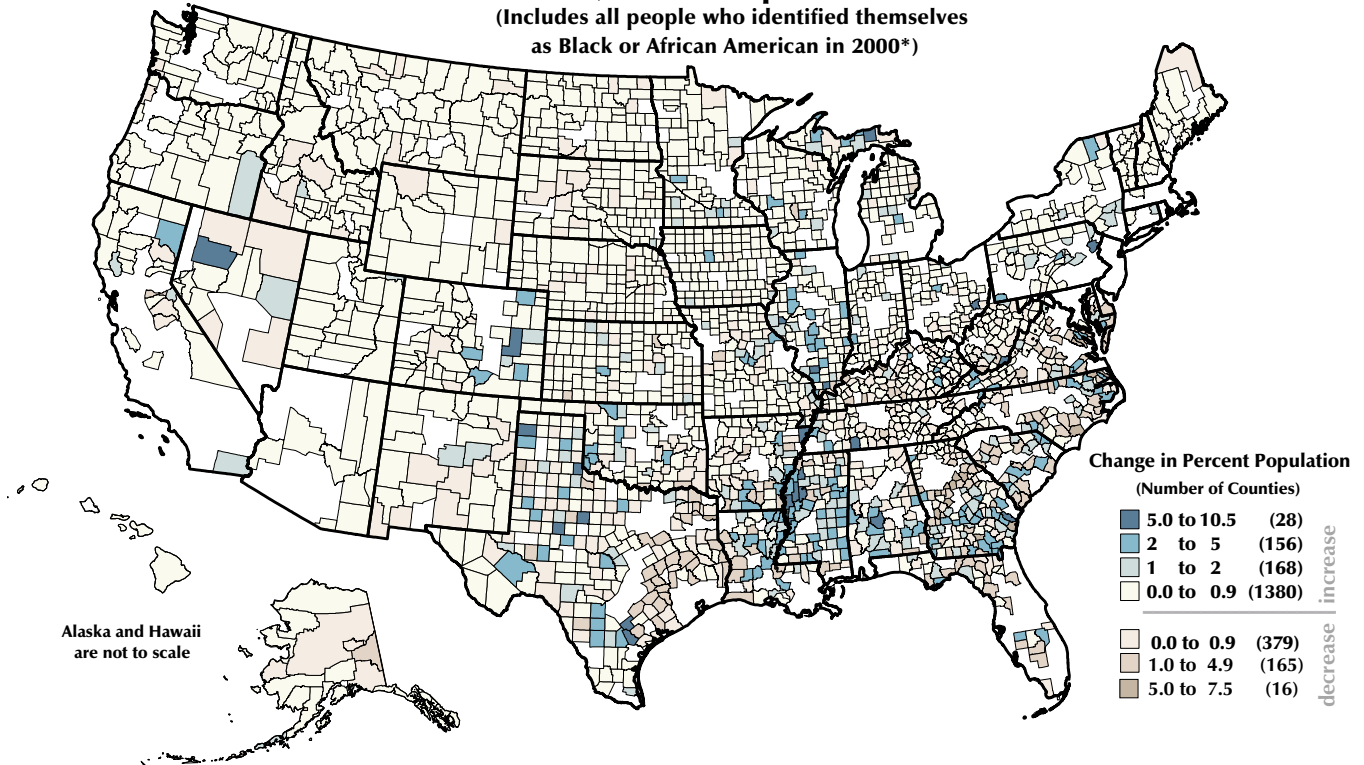


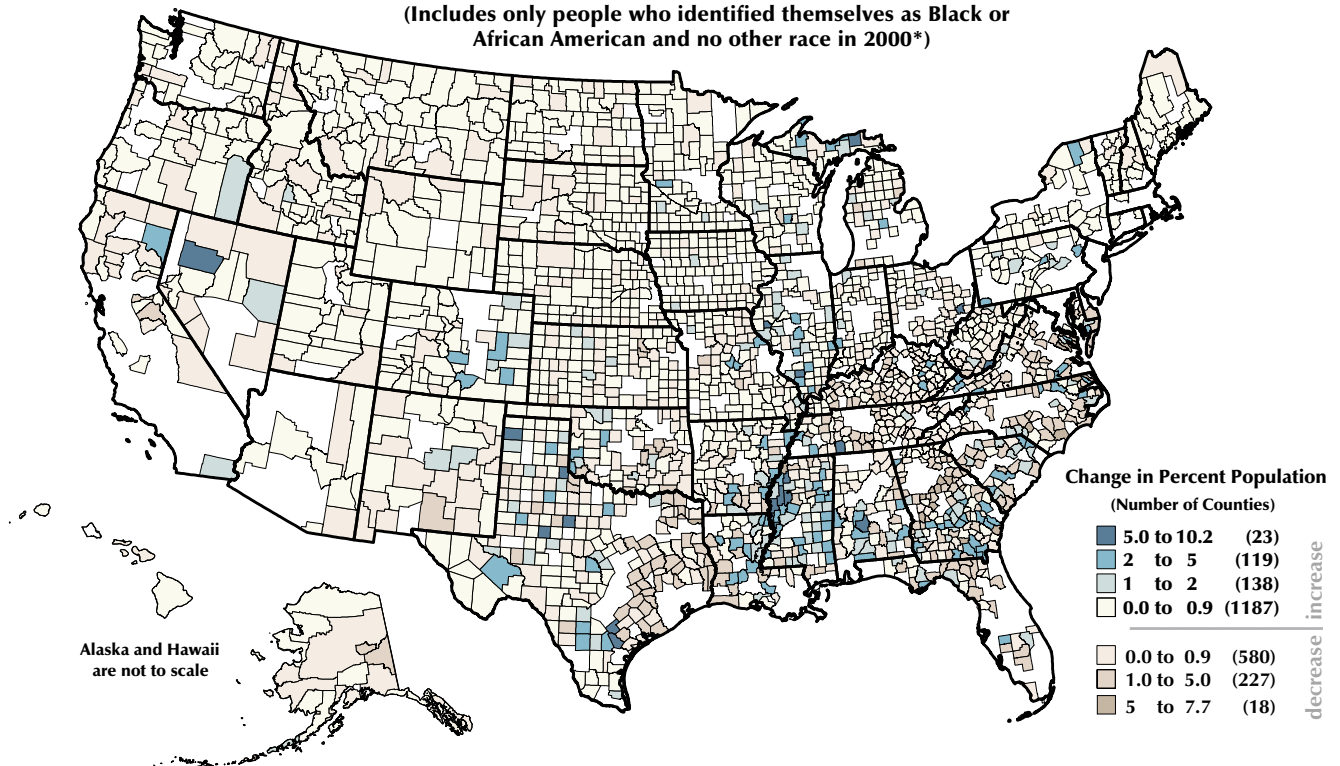
Change in Percent Black or African American 1990-2000, Nonmetropolitan Counties

Metropolitan Areas are omitted. The New England County Metropolitan Area (NECMA) definition is used to classify nonmetropolitan counties in New England.

*In the 1990 Census, respondents were allowed to choose only one race; they could choose more than one race in the 2000 Census.

All people choosing Black includes those who chose only Black and those who chose Black and at least one other race. Only people choosing Black includes those who only chose Black and no other race.
