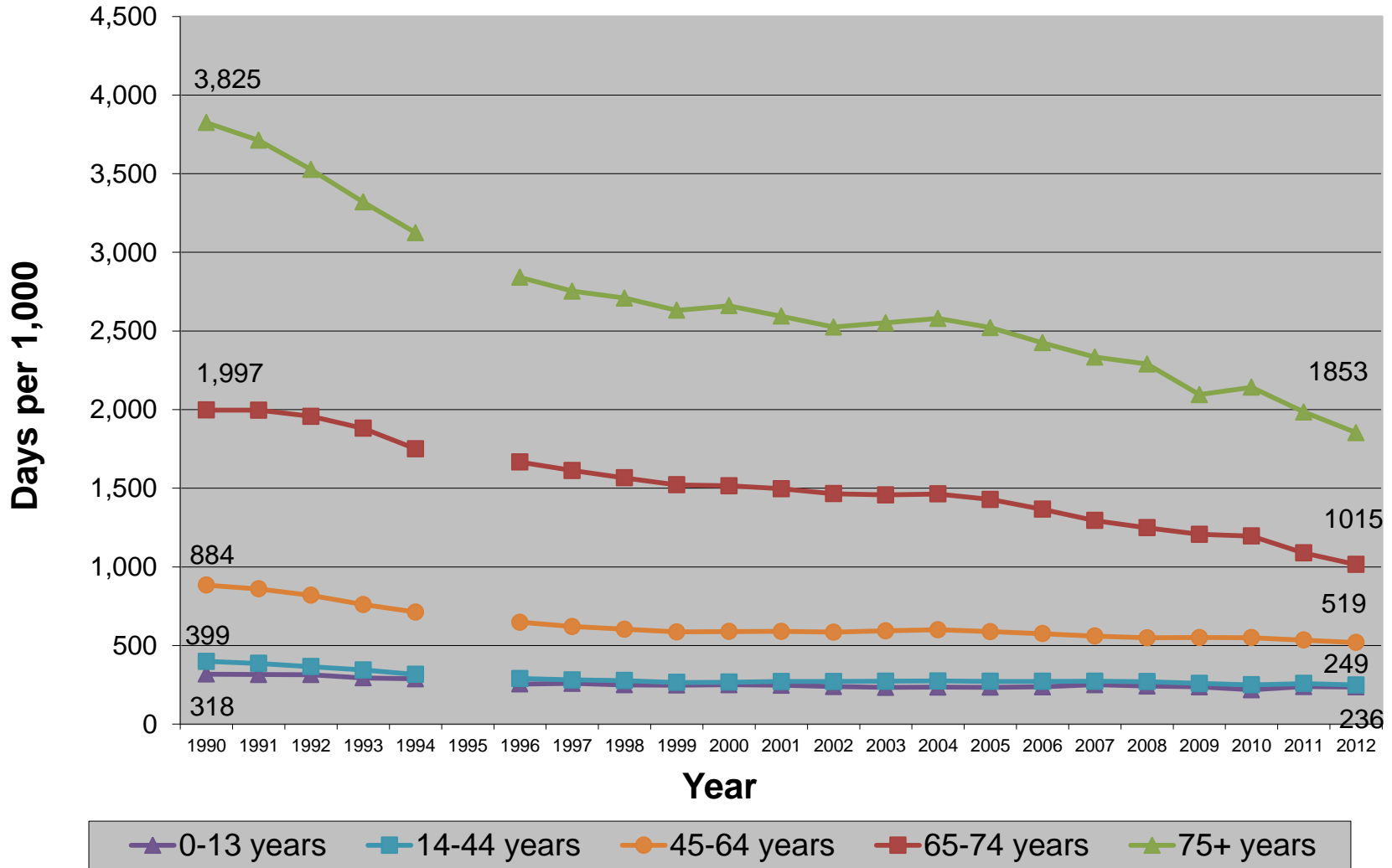
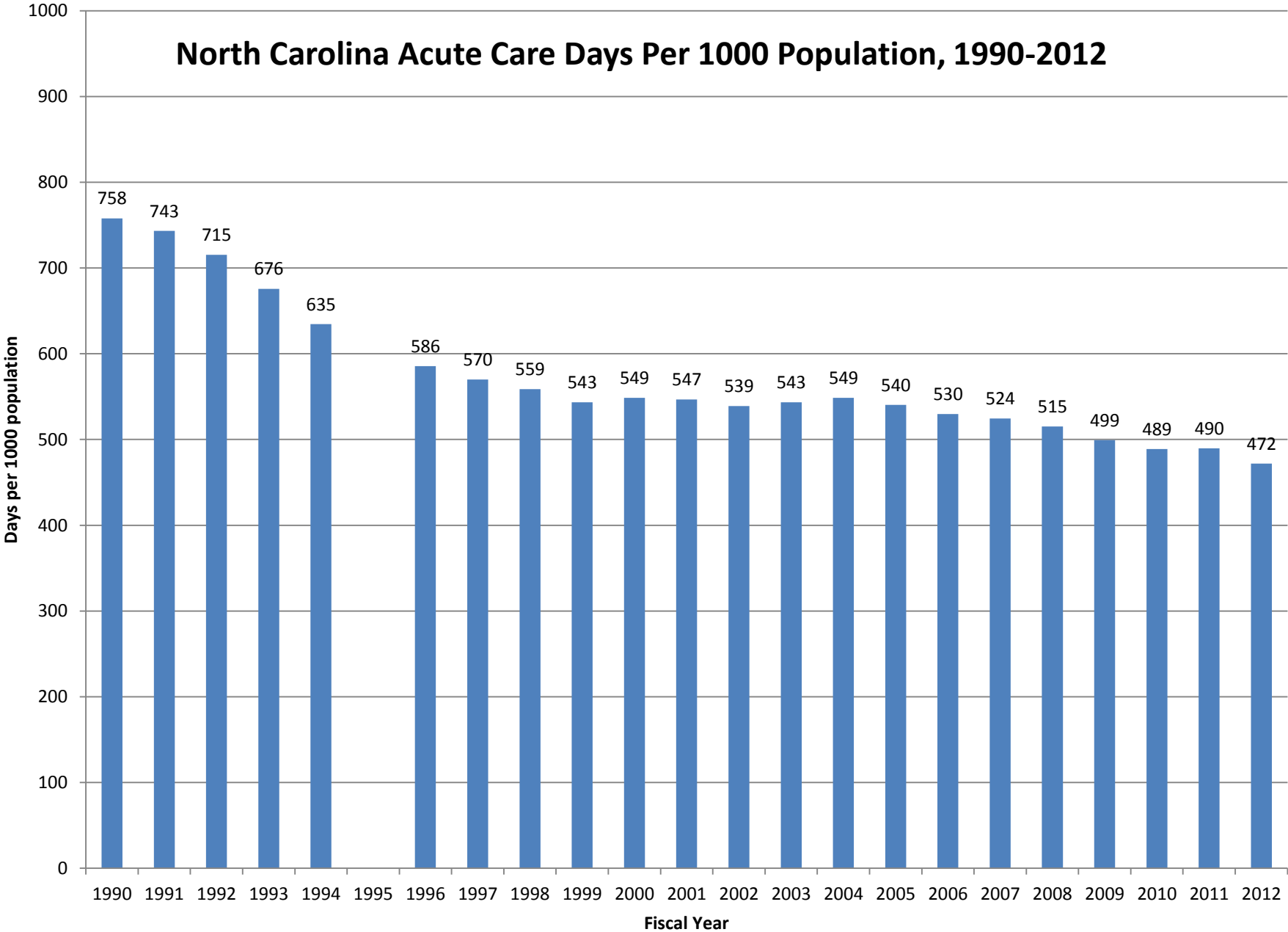


NC Acute Care Hospital Days per 1,000 Population October 1, 1989 to September 30, 2012

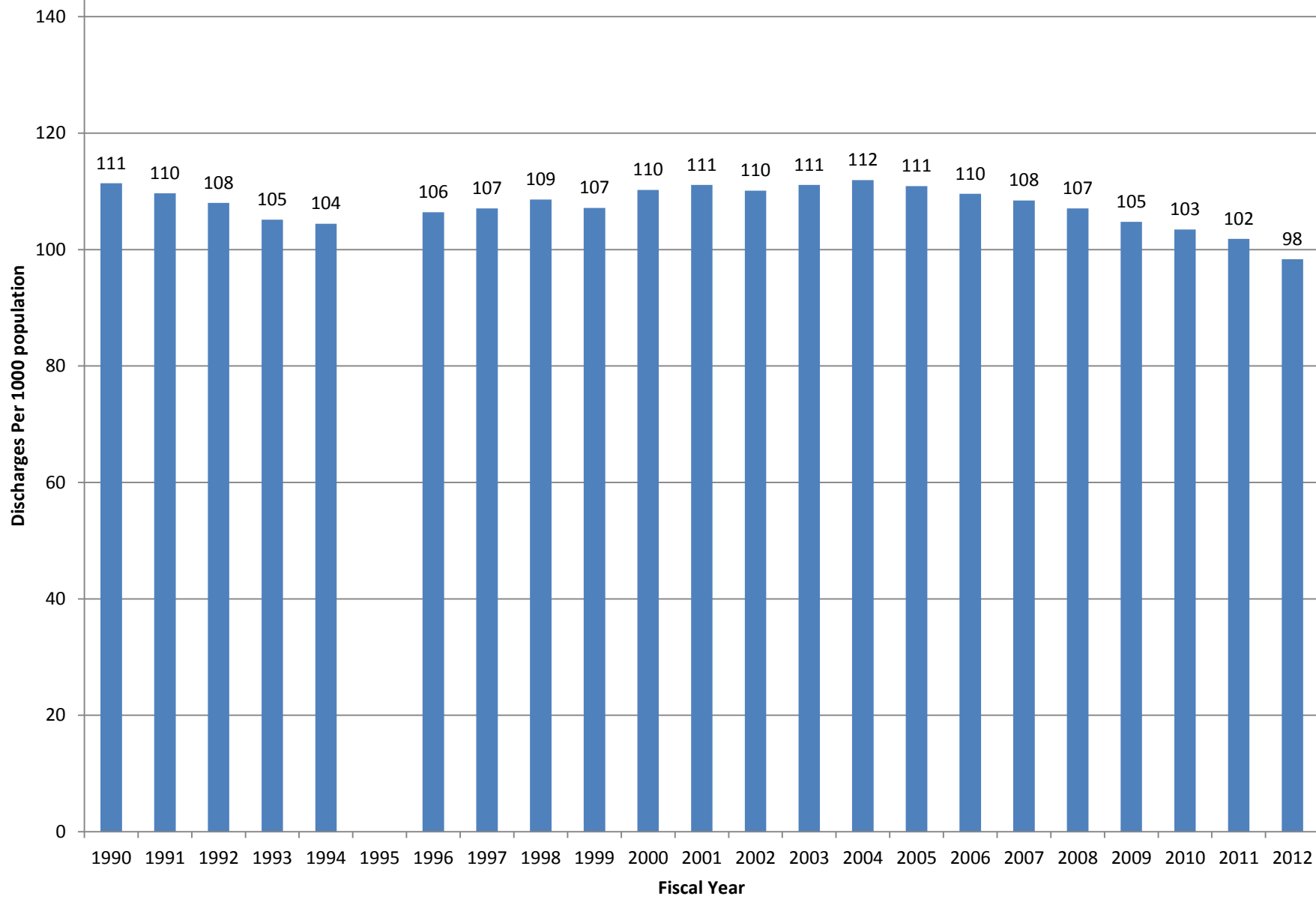
North Carolina Acute Care Days Per 1000 Population, 1990-2012

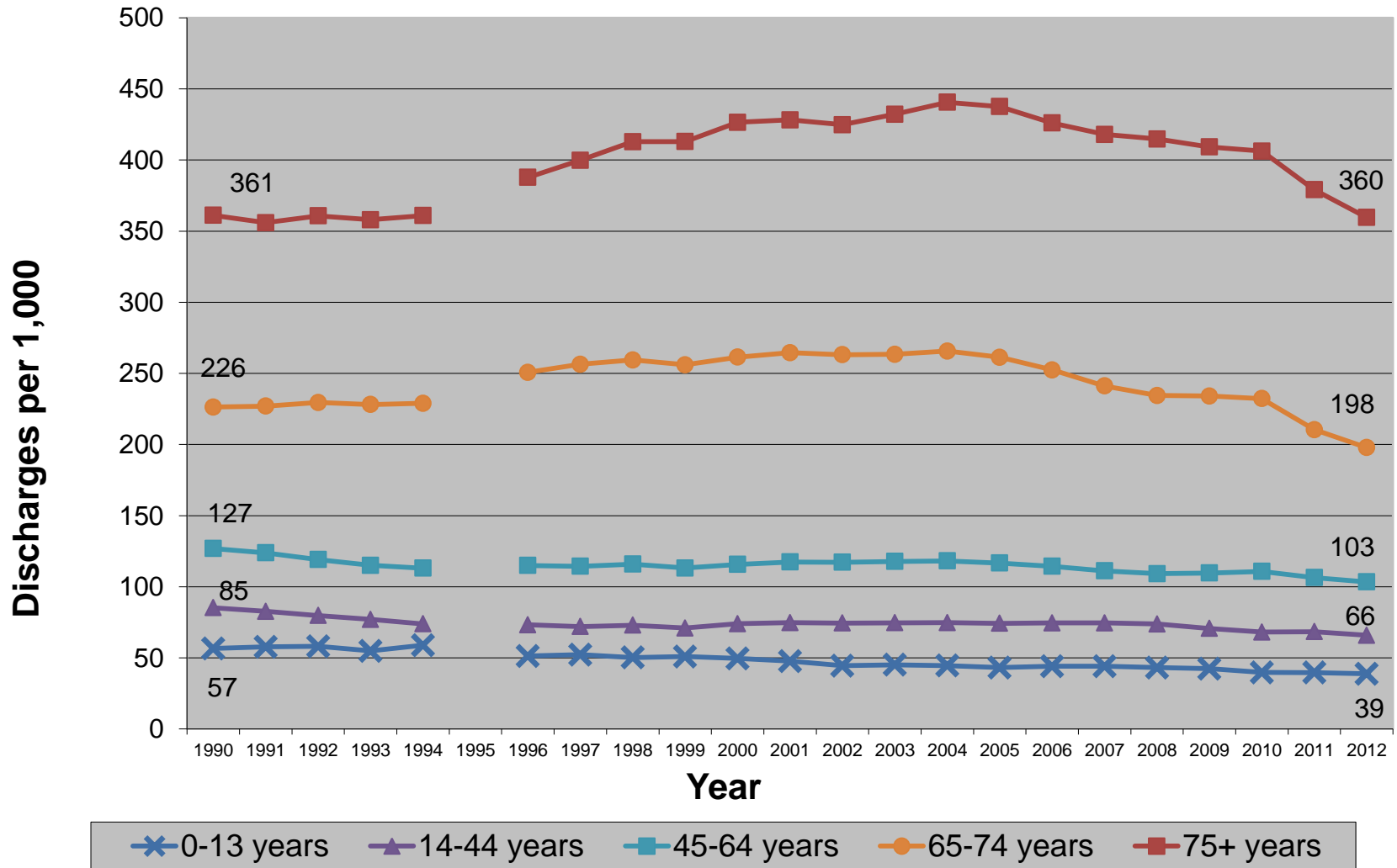
North Carolina Acute Care Discharges Per 1000 population, 1990-2012
