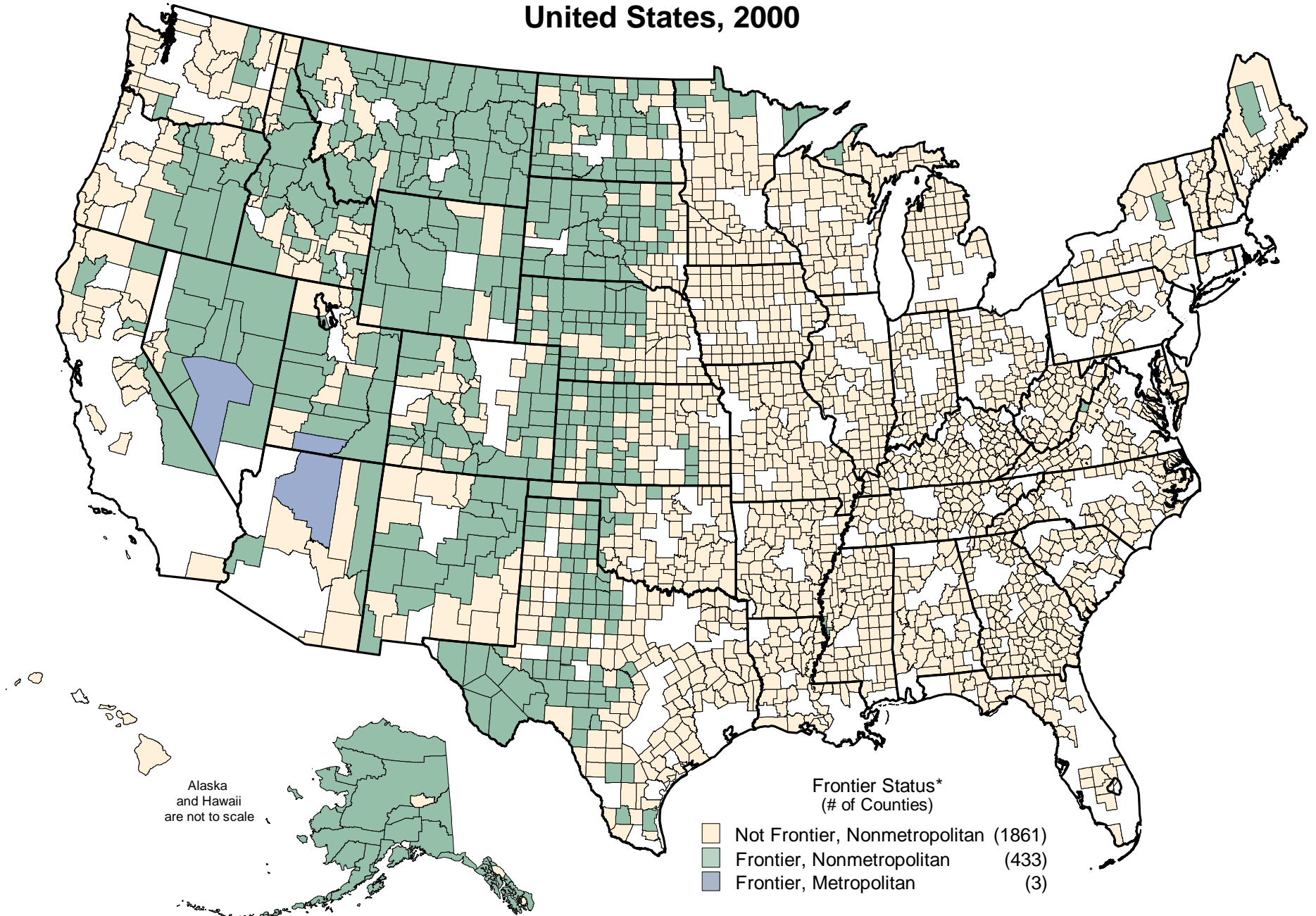


Frontier Counties United States, 2000
